

SYLVAN GROVE STATION WX4BCA NOW INSTALLED

At long last the funds were made available, the equipment was purchased and Station WX4BCA was installed in our new location at the Sylvan Grove Hospital.

On Tuesday morning, September 1, Mike AJ4GU, Darlene KK4BKF, Ken KM4HOS and Buzz K3GWK met at Sylvan Grove Hospital for installed through a section of the basement wall. There is still plenty of room for more cables to be installed as needed.

The VHF repeater has also been moved to the "radio room." Mike will be installing it in a 6" rack and getting the controller on-line soon. The rack we will be using is the same



a 6 hour work detail. They extended the antenna cables and set up the new ham station at the hospital.

The station is located in the basement adjacent to the Maintenance Department Office. Getting the cables (3 Coax and 1 Hardline) through the wall was quite a project. Ken (KM4HOS) was able to drill a hole big enough for a 3" PVC sleeve to be rack that housed the 147.285 repeater when it sat atop the Georgia Power office building.

The station consists of a Yaesu FT-450D and MFJ Auto-Tuner on HF and an ICOM ID-5100 for UHF and VHF FM (with D-STAR). There is a donated Windows 7 PC and printer.

Many thanks to the Technical Team that worked hard to make our station a reality. Ω



2015 ARES Simulated Emergency Test October 3, 2015

The annual ARES SET will be held on October 3rd this year, from 08:30 until Noon. This year's SET will involve providing communications for the Butts County Department of Public Health at a simulated Point of Distribution or POD. Our team will be operating two or three stations. One will be the new ham station at Sylvan Grove Hospital staffed by the SGH Response Team ops.

We will also be setting up at least one portable station at the BC DPH office, 463 Ernest Biles Drive in Jackson (across from the Ernest Biles Recreation Center). If we have operators available we will also set up a voice only link to the secondary POD site. Our goal is to be able to communicate from the DPH station to the hospital using FM voice and digital, both on our repeater and on Simplex.

Additionally we will be testing HF communications between Jackson and the District DPH office in LaGrange and also with the "State Operations Center" in Atlanta. Fldigi with Flmsg will be the primary method used. Our HF station at SGH will also be checking in to the state ARES net on 3.975.00. We will also try to communicate, using digital, with ARES stations in Henry, Newton and Spalding counties. Ω





FROM THE BACKACRE — BUZZ (K3GWK) Butts County Emergency Coordinator

I don't know about you but I am tired of the rainy days. The yard here at "Kutcher's Backacre" is a swamp, going to have to put off cutting the grass for a while. I do enjoy the cooler mornings though; getting out on the screened porch and enjoying my morning coffee and the antics of the local hummingbird fleet.

As you read this the SET (part one, at least) is behind us. The second half will take place in November on the 13th and 14th. If requested, we will respond to support our local Public Health Department. More on that later.

The station at Sylvan Grove is set up and operating thanks to a lot of effort from Mike (AJ4GU), Darlene (KK4BKF) and Ken (KM4HOS). Over 60 ham hours were put into getting this long awaited station on the air.

The project included moving or extending coax and hard-line feeds, moving the VHF repeater, set up and programming of the radios and some on air testing with stations around the state. The station has phone and digital capabilities on UHF, VHF and HF. It also has D-STAR capabilities on UHF and VHF.

There is still some work to do. An operating manual is needed

(Darlene and Ken are working on that). The station has a PC but no Internet connection; Sylvan Grove engineering is working on that. A

permanent flat screen monitor is also needed. It will be a "work in progress" for some time but it is well equipped and ready.

up – great chance for some ATNO (All Time New One) contacts.

Just a note about the Digital Training Workshop held on August 29th. The session was very well attended; our group had 16 hams in attendance out of a total of 29. The morning session on D-STAR and DRATS gave us all a

taste of something new.
The session after lunch was an excellent NBEMS tune-up opportunity. A big thank you to John

Davis (WB4QDX), Ed Woodrick (WA4YIH), Roy Baker (AJ4GT), Paul Carrin (KE4KXV) and Mike Crowe (AJ4GU) for their assistance. The facility at Piedmont/Henry hospital was excellent. I will try to get John back for a session just on D-STAR using the ID-5100 radio. The UHF/VHF radio at Sylvan Grove is an ID-5100.

The Basic CERT class is

continuing with a good crew from Butts County ARES in attendance. Greg (KM4HOY), Ken (KM4HOS), Brent (KA3ZPM), Anthony (KM4DHZ) and Dennis (KM4MHW) are taking the class. Our ARES group is the communications team for Butts County CERT.

Well that's it for this report. I have the HF radio on and listening to the Hurricanes Net on 14.325. There isn't much activity right now but I expect it will get busy as Joaquin moves through the Caribbean and then up the US East Coast.

Please work on those Basic ARES and ICS courses. Hopefully the introduction to the Incident Command System at the September meeting helped you to understand why they are important. The courses are free and on-line from FEMA at http://training.fema.gov/nims/.
